Starting to dive

Utilising a local pool and classrooms in Leeds Premier Diving offers:

PADI Discover Scuba (£25): your first taste of breathing underwater in the safe confines of a pool in North Leeds.

PADI Open Water: learn the core diving skills in the pool (£195) then experience your first four open water dives in the UK (further £155).

Develop your experience

PADI Advanced Open Water (£250): extend your underwater experience and knowledge with an Instructor, through five Adventures Dives.

EFR - Emergency First Response (£95): a first aid qualification which is a pre-requisite to the Rescue Diver course. Also available to non divers.

PADI Rescue Diver (£275): working with other divers, learn how to help others, this course combines EFR and diving skills.

Specialities

Hone your skills in specific areas and begin to develop your dive related knowledge and skills. An extensive range of PADI Specialities is available including:

Wreck (£175): a four dive course to learn to plan and execute a dive that includes penetrating a wreck!

Deep (£180): a four dive course to qualify you to dive to a maximum depth of 40m.

Dry Suit (£125): a two dive speciality so you can dive warm and toasty in UK waters.

Navigation (£150): follow the blue fins! Seriously, learn to navigate underwater using a variety of methods.

Enriched Air (£95): sometimes called Nitrox, this course explores basic dive science so that you are able to take advantage of different air mixes to safely extend your no decompression limits. Two dives can be added for £30.
